

The MP's seek various relief. I have heard argument today on whether at law, Mr Stinson was entitled to voluntarily assign the 4 companies in receivership into bankruptcy. I have advised counsel that I will attempt to release reasons on this issue tomorrow. Until my reasons are released, the trustee is enjoined from taking any steps actions + from making any communications with respect to the subject bankruptcies as is Mr. Stinson on his own behalf or on behalf of the subject companies.
